


BARS AND TIME SIGNATURES





A sign like this is called a double bar-line – it tells you
that you have reached the end of the piece.



- Signs like 2_4 , 3_4 and 4_4 are called **time signatures**; they are usually only written once, at the start of the first bar of a piece of music.

- Top numbers tell you how many beats in a bar, bottom numbers the kind of beat.

The most common number at the bottom is 4, which means the beat is a crotchet.

– Sometimes the letter ${f c}$ is used: this stands for **common time** and is another way of writing 4_4 .
