




RESTS

Signs called **rests** are used to show silence in music: they tell you when to stop playing and how long to be silent for. Here are four commonly used rests:

 the **semibreve** (whole note) rest = 4 counts

 the **minim** (half note) rest = 2 counts

 the **crotchet** (quarter note) rest = 1 count

 the **quaver** (eighth note) rest = ½ count

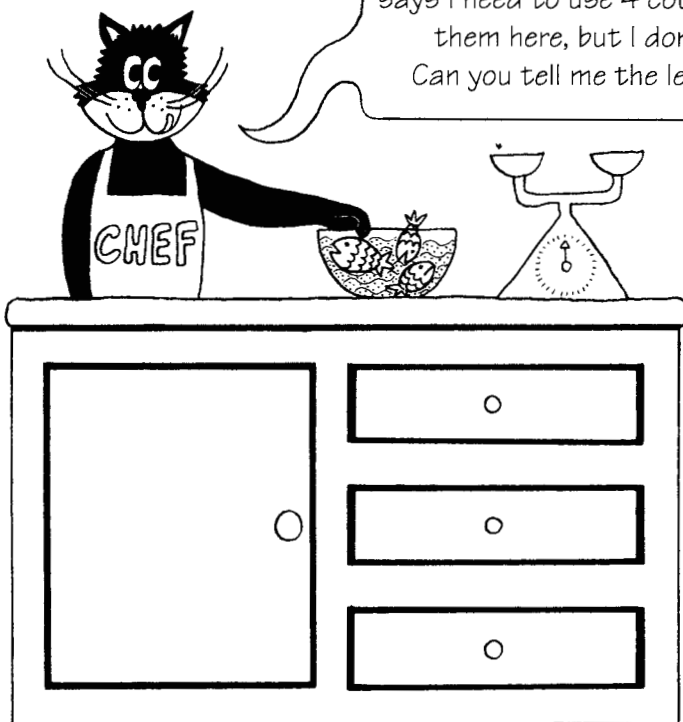


When a silence lasts a whole bar (no matter what the time signature) a semibreve rest is used.
