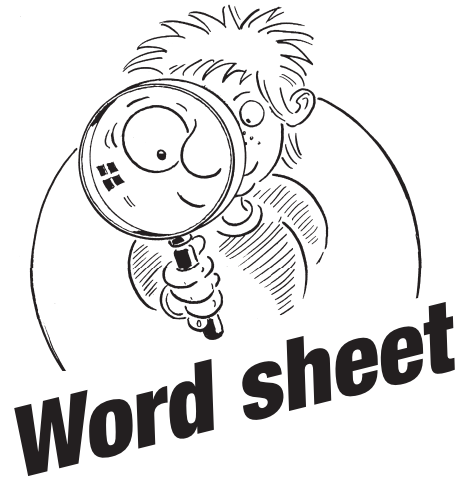


Singing BOOK 3 Sherlock
